## **COOKIES POLICY**

## WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Our website uses both permanent and session cookies that are necessary for the website to function properly, e.g. by allowing you to browse the website and to access certain functions and areas of the website. Certain services or functions such as submitting our contact form cannot be used without these cookies. Our website does not store any cookies for a longer period than one year.

Our website also uses cookies from Google Analytics to keep statistics of our website users to be able to improve the website.
